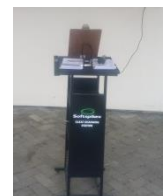
Concerns have arisen. One of our members, Paul Colcord, has not been seen since winning 10kg of chocolate at prizegiving. Please look out for him.

A follow up spray of the daisy was done on Tuesday; the plant seems to be dying well. Thanks to the ladies for understanding the closures we had to make on the day as the good weather window we had was small.

You may have noticed the oil marks on the greens; this was from a fine hydraulic o-ring leak in the valve bank of the greens mower which failed in the weekend. The oil is very hard to see on the grass until a few hours later, the problem was fixed half way through the Sunday mow and the greens were finished off. We have given the greens a dose of fertiliser to help grow out the oil burn, any remaining damage will be fixed up with the upcoming coring and seeding.

We are looking to fork the soft approaches of the greens in the coming weeks to allow more air into the soil and help with drainage, if you have a garden fork and some spare time feel free to come along and help out it would be much appreciated, just call in to the shed and we can give you a few instructions and send you in the right direction.

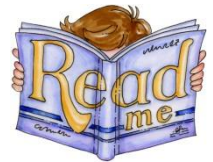
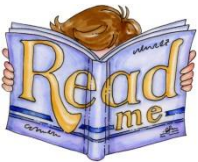
